


## HERITAGE COUNCIL DETERMINATION

At a meeting of the Heritage Council of Victoria on 6 August 2020 it was determined that, in accordance with section 49(1)(a) and 49(1)(e) of the Heritage Act 2017, the place is of cultural heritage significance to the State of Victoria and is to be included in the Heritage Register, as a Registered Place, and that objects integral to understanding the cultural heritage significance of the place, as listed on page 2 of the Executive Director's recommendation, are of State-level cultural heritage significance and are to be included in the Heritage Register as Registered Objects integral to understanding the cultural heritage significance of the place.

This decision was reached having considered the assessment against the Heritage Council's criteria and information included in the Executive Director's recommendation. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining that the place has cultural heritage significance at the State level are generally in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.
