

HERITAGE COUNCIL DETERMINATION

The Heritage Council of Victoria determined on **1 December 2022** that:

- the above place is of State-level cultural heritage significance and should be included in the Victorian Heritage Register as a registered place in accordance with section 49(1)(a) of the Act;
- the recommended extent of registration before the above place are appropriate under section 49(1)(d) of the Act; and
- the categories of works or activities which may be carried out in relation to the place for which a permit is not required (permit exemptions) are to be included, pursuant to section 49(3) in accordance with the Executive Director's recommendation, but for the 'general' condition which reads "*Works generally in accordance with Planning Permit 5/2021/126 issued on 16 June 2021 for the library development, where these works are located within the extent of registration*" which is to be replaced with "*Works in accordance with the plans for the library development endorsed on 08/09/2022 relating to Planning Permit 5/2021/126 issued on 16 June 2021, where these works are located within the extent of registration.*"

This decision was reached having considered the assessment against the Heritage Council's criteria, the information included in the Executive Director's statement of recommendation, and seven (7) submissions received in response. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining to include the above place in the Heritage Register are generally in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.
