

Heritage Council Determinations

Expedited amendments

On 1 November 2024 the Executive Director recommended that the Heritage Council make three expedited amendments in accordance with section 63(1) of the Heritage *Act 2017*. On 19 November the Heritage Council gave 28 days written notice to the owners, government asset managers and responsible authorities for each of the below places, in accordance with section 63(2) of the *Heritage Act 2017*.

The Heritage Council received correspondence from responsible authorities in relation to the Delegate River Gold Diversion Tunnel, and Christ Church, Brunswick. Neither objected to the expedited amendments. The Heritage Council has referred the correspondence to the Executive Director. No correspondence or objection in relation to the Regent Picture Theatre was received.

On 6 January 2025 the below determinations were made by the Heritage Council of Victoria in accordance with section 63 of the *Heritage Act 2017*:

Delegate River Gold Diversion Tunnel, Pretty Gully Track, Delegate River and Bendoc, East Gippsland Shire (H1261)

The above place is to be amended in the Heritage Register, by making the following amendments:

- Correcting the gazetted extent of the place to reflect its true location.
- Changing the address from 'Tunnel Ridge Track, Delegate River and Bendoc, East Gippsland Shire' to 'Pretty Gully Track, Delegate River and Bendoc, East Gippsland Shire'.
- Including a diagram with the gazettal.

This decision was reached having considered the information included in the Executive Director's statement of recommendation. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining to make the above amendments to the Heritage Register are in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.

Regent Picture Theatre, 51–57 Lydiard Street North, Ballarat Central, Ballarat City (H2221)

The above place is to be amended in the Heritage Register, by making the following amendment:

• Amending the address of the Registered Place to 51–57 Lydiard Street North, Ballarat Central.

This decision was reached having considered the information included in the Executive Director's statement of recommendation. The Heritage Council's reasons for determining to make the above amendment to the Heritage Register are in accordance with the reasons of the Executive Director.

Christ Church, 8–10 Glenlyon Road, Brunswick, Merri-bek City Council (H0129)

The above place is to be amended in the Heritage Register, by making the following amendment:

• Amending Diagram 129 (extent of registration) to correct a mapping error.
